WHO IS THE PROGRAMME FOR?

The PPL programme is designed for C-Suite level leaders and those who aspire to the role; assisting in your transition as leaders in private, public and civil society sectors, and who are looking to lead their organisations effectively. Success of the course depends on commitment and active participation in discussions and group work that will be conducted entirely in English.

PPL is delivered over 2 weeks with 10 half-day sessions or an intensive full day 5 day session.
